CONSENT ORDER

AND UPON the Fourth Proposed Defendant's application by letter dated 24 May 2023, with the consent of the Proposed Class Representative, for an extension to the deadline for an application to dispute the Tribunal's jurisdiction under rule 34(4) the Tribunal Rules

AND HAVING REGARD TO rule 76(12) of the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

1. Subject to paragraph 2, the deadline by which the Fourth Proposed Defendant shall make an application to dispute the Tribunal's jurisdiction under Rule 34(4) of the Tribunal Rules be extended until 56 days after the date on which any Collective Proceedings Order ("CPO") is made by the Tribunal in these proceedings.

2. If an application for permission to appeal any such CPO or judicial review proceedings in respect of such CPO are commenced, the deadline by which the Fourth Proposed Defendant shall make an application to dispute the Tribunal's jurisdiction shall be deferred until 30 days after the date on which the CPO is no longer subject to appeal or judicial review.
3. Liberty to apply.
4. Costs in the case.
